# **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**ON ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES**

**UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA** (hereinafter referred to as "UPM"), an institution of higher learning established under the Universities and University Colleges Act 1971 [Act 30] of Malaysia whose address is at 43400 UPM, Serdang, Selangor Darul Ehsan, Malaysia and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns;

**AND**

**UNIVERSITAS NEGERI PADANG** (hereinafter referred to as UNP), an institution of higher education established under Jenderal Pendidikan Tinggi Depdikbud Nomor 1499/D/1996 whose address is at Jalan Professor Doktor Hamka, Air Tawar, Air Tawar Barat, Padang Utara, Kota Padang, Sumatera Barat INDONESIA 25131 and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns;

(hereinafter referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties").

## **WHEREAS**

- A. UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA is an established University which strives to enhance and strengthen its research and development and has taken various initiatives to complement its educational excellence and has entered into various collaborative arrangements with other parties to enhance networking;
- B. UNIVERSITAS NEGERI PADANG is an established University and Indonesia university with focus on *Manajemen Publik*, *Manajemen Pemasaran* and *Manajemen Sumber Daya Manusia*; and
- C. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

**HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING** as follows:

## **ARTICLE I** **OBJECTIVE**

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop research co-operation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

**ARTICLE II**  
**AREAS OF CO-OPERATION**

1. Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter in their respective countries, endeavour to take necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:
  - a. Students Exchange programme
  - b. Staff exchange and visiting professor program
  - c. Organization of joint conferences and seminars such as research, education and development studies
  - d. Short term study visit and training programs for students and staff
  - e. Capacity building program
2. For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 1 the Parties will enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties including clauses on "confidentiality", "suspension", protection of intellectual property rights" and "settlement of dispute" as contained in Annexure A1 of this Memorandum of Understanding.

**ARTICLE III**  
**FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to other.
2. Each Party will bear its own cost and expenses in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding.

**ARTICLE IV**  
**EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

**ARTICLE V**  
**NO AGENCY**

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organisation of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

**ARTICLE VI**  
**ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION**

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of five (5) years.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.

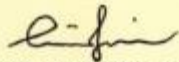

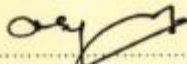

**PADANG**, METRO – Fakultas Ilmu Keolahragaan Universitas Negeri **Padang** (FIK UNP) kembali siap menggelar Konferensi Internasional. Bertajuk International Conference Sport And Coaching (ICSCoach) bakal dihelat di Auditorium kampus beralamat di Jalan Prof. Dr. Hamka, Air Tawar Padang (15/10) mendatang.

Sebelumnya, konferensi internasional juga telah digelar oleh Jurusan Pendidikan Olahraga, dan berselang untuk bulan depan kali ini giliran Jurusan Kepelatihan FIK UNP yang akan gelar konferensi internasional. Ketua Panpel ICSCoach, Prof. Eri Barlian kepada pewarta di kantor jurusan Kepelatihan kampus itu, Jumat (13/9) mengatakan, seiring misi dari UNP yakni UNP World Class University (Universitas Kelas Dunia) dan sesuai arahan dan instruksi rektor masing-masing jurusan di setiap fakultas di UNP wajib menggelar Konferensi Internasional atau Seminar Internasional. Sebanyak enam pembicara utama (keynote speakers) didatangkan yakni Prof Madya Dr. Tengku Fadilah Tengku Kamalden dari Universiti Putra Malaysia, Dr. Shige Kudo dari Republic Polytecnic, Singapura, Matthew Lantz Blaylock BS, PhD, MP NLP, ACMC dari University of Alabama, Birmingham (Inggris), Ranil Harshana dari Tennisbpm (R) & Strengthatatk (R), Sri Lanka, Prof. Dr. H. Nurhasan, M. Kes dari UNESA Indonesia, Prof. Dr.

Dr. James Tangkudung, SportMedicine, M.Pd dari Universitas Negeri Jakarta serta Prof. Dr. Phil Yanuar Kiram dari UNP.

“Topik konferensi internasional ini sedikitnya ada delapan yakni sport psychology (psikologi olahraga), sport medicine, sport training, physical activity, sport childhood, sport talent scouting, sport nutrition dan sport other,” terang Eri Barlian. Dikatakan Eri Barlian yang saat memberikan keterangan itu didampingi beberapa panpel lainnya seperti Dr. Donie dan Irfan Arifianto begitu lengkapnya yang menjadi pembahasan dengan keynote speakers juga berkelas sudah level internasional sangat penting bahkan berguna untuk kepelatihan olahraga Wakil Dekan I Dr. Umar Nawawi yang berkesempatan hadir saat konferensi pers itu, menambahkan konferensi internasional yang lebih fokus pada kepelatihan ini sangat penting, makanya diharapkan kepada guru-guru olahraga bisa mengikuti. “Nanti para peserta akan mendapat sertifikat. Bagi para guru yang mendapat sertifikat bisa dipergunakan untuk kenaikan pangkat. Begitu juga bagi para pelatih olahraga, jadi rugi bagi yang tak mau ikut,” imbau Umar Nawawi. Dijadwalkan pula pada November tepatnya 13 sampai 14 November giliran Jurusan Ilmu Keolahragaan (Ikor) yang gelar konferensi internasional.
